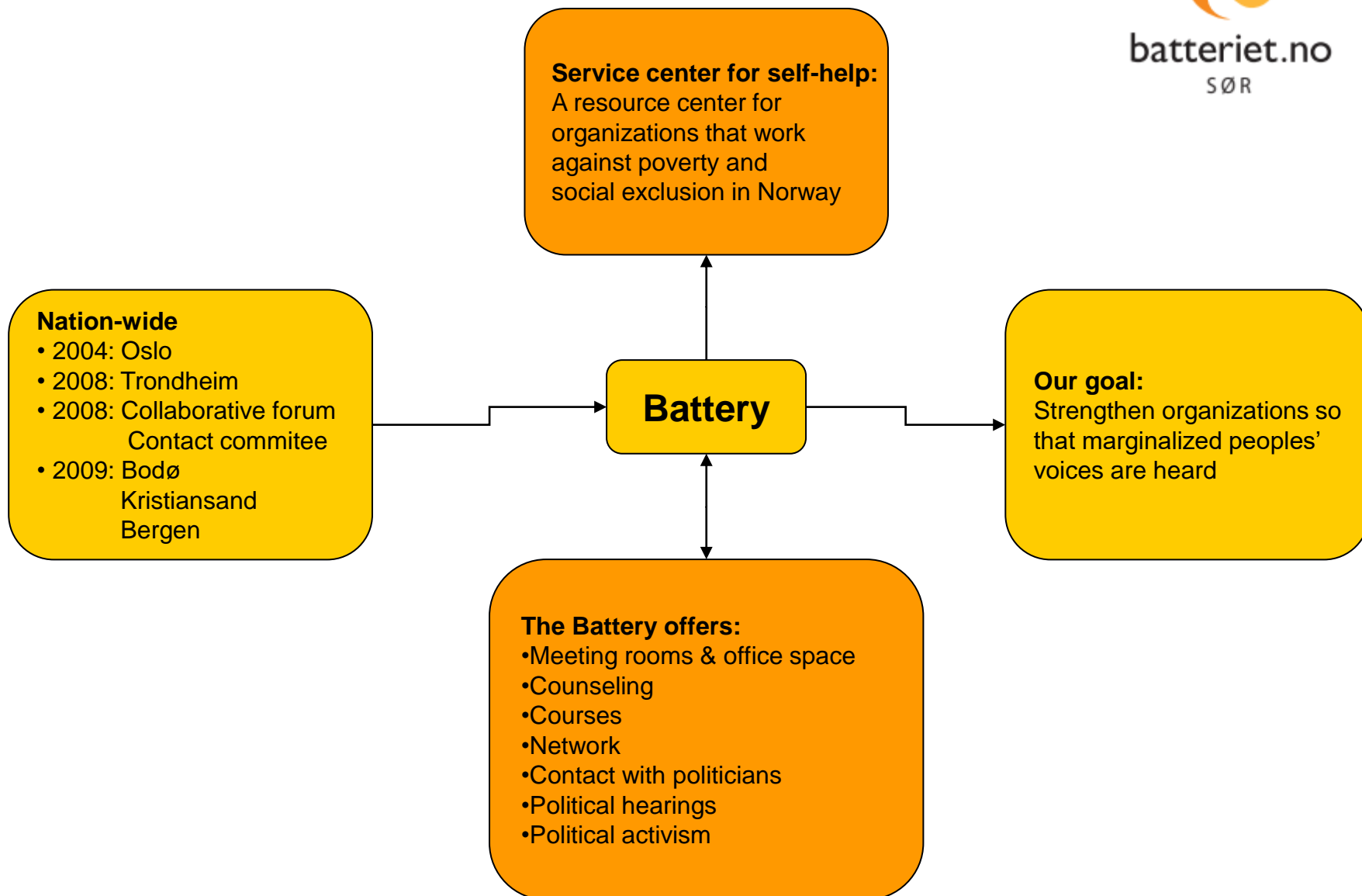
Batteriet

Key figures, 2021



- 55 organizations in contact with Batteriet
- 36 organizations in contact with Batteriet more than once
- 20 organizations in contact with Batteriet more than five times
- 19 organizations used the office space
- 69 times was the office space in use by organizations (240 before Covid 19)
- 8 courses
- 9 events

- Integration 70%
- Youth 18%
- Mental Health 14%

Method - Empowerment

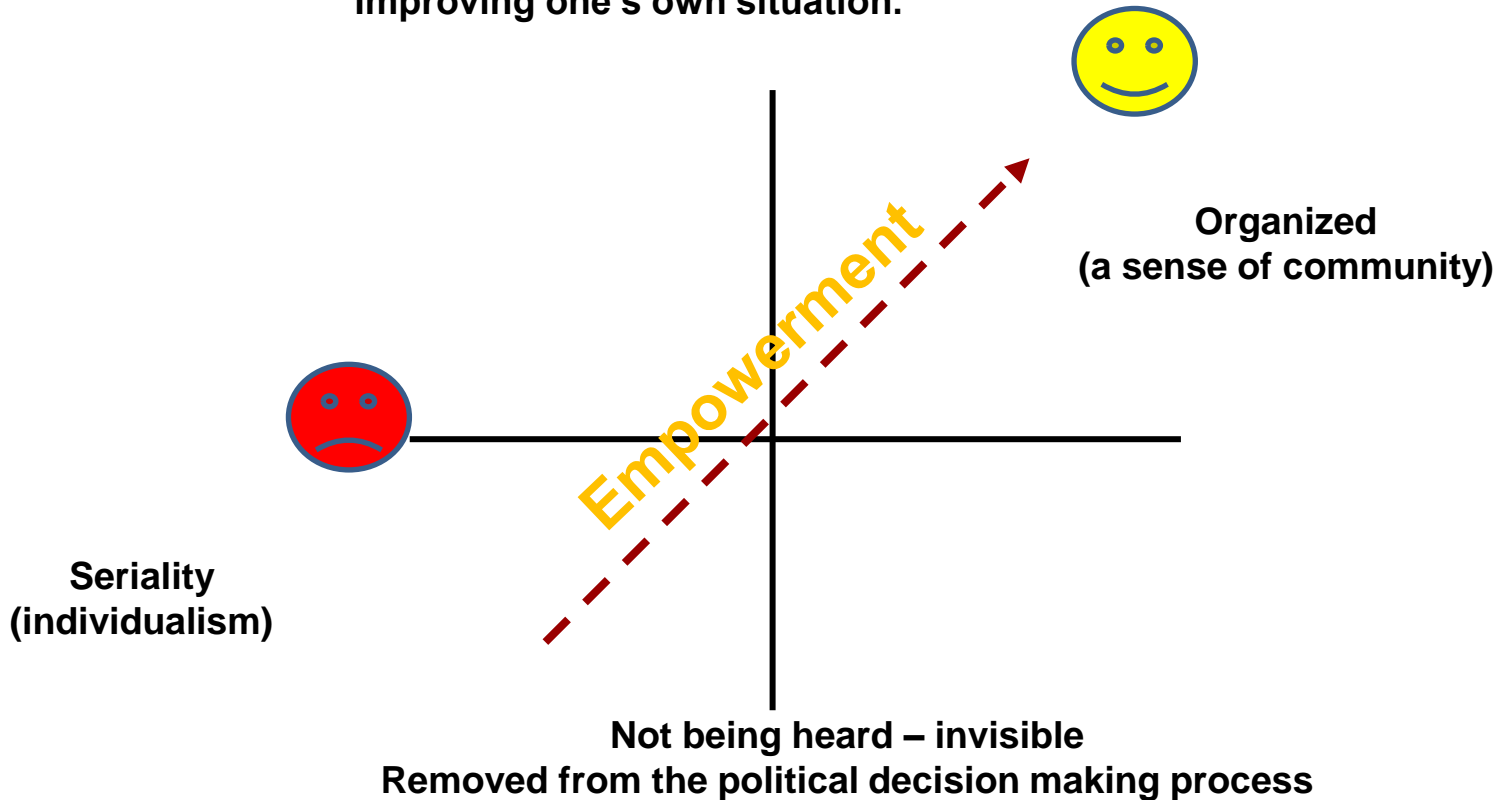


- Empowerment means **people having power and control over their own lives**. People get the support they need *that is right for them*.
- Empowerment means that people are *equal citizens*
- To give someone more confidence and/or strength to do something, often by enabling them to increase their control over their own life or situation



Moving towards visibility via empowerment

Being heard - visible
Participation in the political decision making process.
Improving one's own situation.



The Battery effect

1. Give people hope that their actions matters.
2. Give people hope that they can make a change for them self and others.
3. Contribute to a person saying to them self «I am something, I can do something».
